MAYORS CUP: A HISTORY

The Mayor's Cup Returns for Twenty-First Year.

The Mayor's Cup began in 2002 as result of a combined effort between Maumelle Country Club's PGA Professional Cimmaron Grubb, The Country Club of Arkansas' PGA Professional, Tim Jenkins, and the Mayor of Maumelle at the time, Burch Johnson. The three decided on a 20 person squad for each team which included 16 men and 4 women playing in a Ryder Cup-like format over two days, with each course hosting one of the rounds.

The first Mayor's Cup was decided by the final pairing on the final hole of the final day. When Maumelle Country won the cup PGA Pro, Cimmaron Grubb, uncorked the champagne spraying the crowd in jubilation and this started a really special rivalry. The event is held annually near the end of October to fittingly "cap" the tournament season for each club.

For the next decade The Country Club of Arkansas dominated the event. Results seemed lopsided much of the time with huge margin of victory after huge margin of victory for CCA. Slowly but surely the Maumelle team retooled, became stronger, and fought their way back to dominate the event in recent years. In this 21st year playing of the cup the two clubs are tied, with each claiming the same number of victories. The Cup is in the possession of Maumelle Country Club, which means CCA must win outright in order to bring the cup home.

Throughout the years the event has added players and the player-count now stands at 26 for each team.
