## GREENS UPDATE

You can't beat Mother Nature. Many courses in the region, including ours, are struggling to return to form following a rainy and cold first quarter. It will remain a struggle until night-time temperatures creep up to the 60s for weeks at a time. Once we get some warm weather we should see a massive and almost immediate recovery.

We recently sodded the greens of holes two and four, and also sodded some poor areas of some other greens. While they look incredible, it takes repeated aerations, top-dressings, and rolling for sodded greens to completely smooth-out. It takes work and it takes time. In terms of creating smooth putting surfaces its far better and far faster to "grow-in" weak areas as opposed to sodding. Most years with normal April weather this "grow-in" would have already been stimulated by warm weather, and the greens would have recovered more by now.

We are in the process of assessing each green as to the best course of action. If we must sod more areas we will. For the time being there are not many Tifeagle farms that have sod. The farms in our region have suffered the same poor growing conditions as us, so harvestable Tifeagle sod is a bit hard to find for the time-being. Our last load was trucked overnight 700 miles from Georgia.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we limp through this process. Hopefully we won't have to go through this for another decade.

Our crew will work all year to reduce wear on the course by controlling cart traffic using signage and ropes. Please do your part by staying on the cart paths when you can, especially around the tees and greens, and also by staying away from areas where cart-wear is becoming evident.
